The main groups of farm animals are:

- Cattle
- Pigs
- Poultry
- Sheep
- Goats
- Horses
- Rabbits



# Technical English

## Farm animals (livestock)

### 1) Cattle

- Are kept for milk and meat (beef)
- Were used as draught animals.
- Cattle breeds are classified as either beef or dairy.
- Cow, bull, calf, heifer, ox
- Cattle live in herds
- Grass-fed cattle, soy-fed cattle, grain-fed cattle
- Holstein, Black Angus, Guernsey




## Farm animals (livestock)

### 2) Pigs

- Are kept for meat (pork)
- Hog, sow, piglet, swine,
- Pigs live in herds ( a herd of swine)
- Are difficult to herd and move for long distances
- Berkshire, Chester White, Danish Landrace

### 3) Poultry

- Birds raised on farms for eggs and meat
- Hens, turkeys, ducks, geese, pigeons,
- They live in flocks
- Hen, chick, rooster,
- Leghorn, Pekin, Bourbon, Pilgrim

### 4) Sheep

- Are kept for meat (mutton), wool and milk
- They live in flocks
- Sheep, ewe, ram, lamb
- Cameroon Sheep, Lincoln, Clun Forrest



# Technical English

## Farm animals (livestock)

### 5) Goats

- Are kept for milk, meat, hairs, skin, medicine
- Goat, nanny, billy goat, kid
- Clear unwanted vegetation for centuries
- Angora, Saanen, Pyrenean





# Technical English

## Farm animals (livestock)

### 6) Horses (Equine industry)

- Are kept for work as beasts of burden or draft animals
- Are kept for pleasure or sport
- Horse, stallion, mare, foal
- Gelding, donkey (draft)
- Hot bloods (*Arabian*), Cold bloods (draft horses *Belgian*), Warm bloods (riding horses *Trakenher*)



# Technical English

## Farm animals (livestock)

### 7) Rabbits

- Are kept for meat and fur
- Rabbit, buck, doe, kitten
- Live in groups
- Dutch, Chinchilla, Czech red



# Technical English

## Farm animals (livestock)



### Breeding

- Producing of offspring, usually animals or plants
- Breeder (a person who practices the vocation of mating carefully selected specimens of the same breed to reproduce specific, consistently replicable qualities and characteristics.)
- Breed (Angus, Pilgrim, Merino)
- Herd book or studbook ( is an official list of animals within a specific breed whose parents are known)


