- **Early American and colonial period** (1492-1776).
- **Period of Revolution** (1776-1820) - The Age of Reason, The American Enlightenment
- **The Romantic Period** (1820-1860) - The American Renaissance, The Antebellum Period= South before Civil War

Historical Background

- **1492** - Christopher Columbus Discovered America
- **1584** - 1st Colony in Virginia was established by sir. Walter Raleigh
- **1607** - Captain Smith established Jamestown /Pocahontas/,
- **1620** - Pilgrim Fathers /Puritans from England came on ship Mayflower/
- **1774** - Boston Tea Party
- **4th July 1776**-The Declaration of Independence /on GB/.

American Indian Literature


- orally transmitted, myths, legends, tales and songs

Genres


- diaries, travel journals, letters, autobiographies, sermons, historical writings and Indian captivity stories

- *Of Plymouth Plantation* - history of the colony, a clear and compelling account of the colony's beginning

- poet

Period of Revolution

1776 - 1820

- „*The Age of Reason*“, „*The American Enlightenment*“

History:

- **1789** - The Constitution was adopted
- the end of the Middle ages
- beginning of Modern period
- social progress, optimistic believes, logic and clear arguments and science

Literature


- no professional writers, lack of audience, difficulties in publishing, emphasis on rationality, ideals of justice, liberty, equality and natural rights of man.

Genres:

- political writings, essays, political speeches, personal letters, grammar, dictionaries, political pamphlets, newspapers, travel books and journals.


Period of Revolution

1776 - 1820



Benjamin Franklin (1706-1790)

- writer, politician, publisher
- *Autobiography* - describes the life of a scientist, journalist and politician, and the difficult road to independence



Thomas Jefferson (1743-1826)

- 3rd president of the USA
- *The Declaration of Independence*

Noah Webster (1758-1843)

- a lexicographer
- *American Dictionary, Spelling Book*



Thomas Paine (1737-1809)

- pamphlets



Hector St. John de Crèvecoeur (1735-1813)

- *Letters from an American Farmer*
- 12 letters - America agrarian paradise


The Romantic Period

1820-1860

- „*The American Renaissance*“
- „*The Antebellum Period*“ = „*South before Civil War*“

History:

- **1846-1848 Mexican War**= colonization of the rest of USA
- **1854** -The Republican Party was founded by A. Lincoln
- *Immigrants / Catholics and Protestants/ came to settle in the West, Social problems /alcohol/*



The Romantic Period

1820-1860

- **Literature:**
- Romanticism was delayed from Europe (app. 20 years) and is connected with the period of expansion and discovery of a distinctive American voice.
- Romantic writers were inspired by the nature, imagination and art.
- They stressed individualism and tried to discover an authentic literary form, content and voice (all at the same time).
- American romantic hero faced risk or certain destruction in the pursuit of metaphysical self discovery
- **Genres:** essays, poems, fiction, short stories, novels, journals, American romance (=dark form and tragic hero).

- poet, radical individualist



- *The Scarlet Letter,*




Herman Melville (1819-1881)
