Mechanical engineering


(designing, making and using machines and tools)

Material used in engineering:

Metallic materials



- Steel and cast iron, aluminum and its alloys, zinc, lead, copper and its alloys, titanium
- Metallic material is used for production of component as well as for working and shaping of products
- They are used also as connecting material

Non- Metallic materials

• Plastics, ceramics, corundum



Methods used in engineering:

Technical drawing (drafting or draughting)

 is the act and discipline of composing plans that visually communicate how something functions or has to be constructed.

Computer-aided design (CAD)

 is the use of computer systems to assist in the creation, modification, analysis, or optimization of a design. CAD output is often in the form of electronic files for print, machining, or other manufacturing operations.







Stages of product's development:

- 1) Product planning (What could it be?),
- Marketing (Who is it for?)
- Design (What does it look like?, sketches)
- 2) Concept phase
- Construction of a test model (prototype) and its evaluation (effectiveness)
- 3) Production and selling new product
