Elementary School

1 teacher in each class

20-30 students

Basic subjects: Math, Reading, Writing, Science, Social Studies

Specials: Art, Music, Physical Education, Computer Science, Library

Inclusion- Students with special needs are included in classrooms, but may have an aid or take certain lessons with a special education teacher.
























Middle School

- Different Teacher for every subject
 - Math, science, social studies, language arts, p.e.
 - One year of music & art
- Students rotate classes throughout the day, and have different peers in each class
- Start a foreign language
 - Usually Spanish, French, or German
- Start of school sports
 - Football, basketball, volleyball, wrestling, cross country running, track & field, cheerleading





High School

- Different Teacher for every subject
 - o Math, science, social studies, language arts, p.e.
- Subjects are more specified
 - Ex. Math is divided into Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, Trigonometry, Precalculus, Calculus
- Students are very involved in clubs and activities
 - Student Council, Volunteer Clubs, Language Clubs, Sports, Band

- Junior and Senior year of High School
- Regular High School classes but with specialized subjects
